**R. E. A. L. LIFE GROUPS and SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES**  
(Relational, Encouraging, Applicable, and Life Changing)

Getting connected with R. E. A. L. Life Groups is the foundation for living a successful Christian Life. Celebration Worship Church (CWC) has the resources to help you get to the level of success that God has called you to. We have many ways for individuals and families to get connected here.

**On Going Service (OGS)** – OGS provides for the basic daily, weekly, and monthly needs of our church, membership, guests, and community.

**Short Term Service (STS)** – STS provides short-term service such as church/community clean up, event planning, or other projects that have a start and finish date (deadline).

**On Going Fellowship OGF** – OGF connects people together on a consistent basis.

**Short Term Fellowship (STF)** – STF is for those that can't make a long-term commitment. This fellowship meets for book discussion, support groups, Bible study, etc.

**S.T.R.I.D.E. Youth Ministry (OGF)**

Spirit Filled Teens Receiving Inspiration through Divine Empowerment. An off the chain fellowship for junior high and high school students.

**The Spot (OGF/OGS)**

A church for youth with a blend of rhythm and praise. An opportunity for youth to express their love for God in worship and the Word!

**Out of this World Children's Ministry (OGS)**

Use your passion for children's learning to connect kids to God through Biblical activities.

**O.O.T.W. Children's Church (OGS/OGF)**

Come help our children, preschool – 5<sup>th</sup> grade, learn about God and the Word through skits, praise and worship, and activities.

**Nursery Care (OGS)**

Provide nurturing and loving care for God's little precious angels, age 6 weeks – 3 years old.

**Edi Phi (OGF)**

A ministry for young adults, ages 18 – 25, to help them overcome struggles they face and set them up for a successful adult life.

### **Accountable Men (OGF)**

Build your faith and develop friendships with strong godly men through fellowship and Bible Study.

### **Accountable MENToring Program (OGS)**

Take one day a week to mentor a son, age 10 – 21, of a single mother.

### **Glorious Women (OGF)**

Fellowship with women with various backgrounds and success stories. Receive healing and comfort in a group of women who are pursuing excellence in Christ.

### **Ms. Lady Like (STS/STF)**

A ministry for young ladies ages 12 – 18. Learn how to be a young lady that God desires to use to accomplish great things for His Kingdom.

### **Keep it Fresh (OGF)**

Keep your marriage strong. Fellowship with other married couples and learn God's way of staying happy and divorce-proofing your marriage.

### **Pre – marital Counseling (STF)**

Thinking about taking the big plunge? Spend 6 weeks before you decide a date learning what it will take to do marriage God's way and how to divorce proof your marriage.

### **Single Parents (OGF)**

Have fun and receive encouragement from other single parents through fellowship and Bible Study.

### **Worship and Arts (OGS/OGF)**

Do you enjoy using your creative gifts and/or performing arts talent for God? Join our worship and arts ministry and grow closer to God through these expressive gifts.

### **Dance (OGS)**

Offer the gift of dance to God during praise and worship and other special events.

### **Musician (OGS)**

Use your skill, expertise and knowledge of playing an instrument in a worship service to bring worship to God. Auditions required.

### **Worship Team (OGS)**

Sing praises unto the Lord during weekly services. If you are energetic, expressive in your worship, and can sing then join the worship team. Auditions required.

### **Celebration Choir (OGS)**

Fellowship with other people who love to sing and lift up the name of Jesus Christ in song during weekly services.

### **Drama and Theatrical Arts**

Present the gospel message through acting. Deliver the weekend message along with the pastor with illustrative sermons.

### **Sound, Video, and Lighting (OGS)**

Enhance the delivery of the choir and worship team, and the sermons through sound, video, and lighting.

### **Praise and Worship Transparencies (OGS)**

Make sure that the words to each song are typed, printed, and displayed during our worship services.

### **Ministry of First Impressions (OGS)**

Use your gift of serving and greeting others to help make our guests feel welcomed during our services.

### **Parking Lot Greeters and Attendants (OGS)**

Be the first smiling face and warm welcome our guests and members see as they enter the parking lot.

Greeters/Hosts (OGS)

Welcome and greet those who enter into the building and give directions to our various ministry locations.

Campus Guides (OGS)

Escort people to various classrooms, children's church, the sanctuary, and other areas of our campus.

Ushers/Care Team (OGS)

Provide friendly service to our guest and members to make their worship experience comfortable and enjoyable.

Guest Packet Preparers (OGS)

Assemble the information for our guests into individual packets.

Pastor's Welcome (OGS)

Assist in serving refreshments for our first time guests after service.

Hospitality (OGS/STS)

Utilize your servant's heart to serve refreshments to our guests and members at special events and services.

**Community Relations (OGS/OGF)**

Serve as coordinators who connect CWC to the community through service and assistance, and community outreach events.

Whole Life Assurance (OGS)

Help meet the basic needs of families in the church and community by serving as a resource to help find food, shelter, clothing, and financial assistance. Partners with other community service providers.

Blaze Abroad (OGS)

Spread the word about Christ and CWC to the unchurched community. Make an invitation to all to attend our weekly services.

Community Outreach Events (STS)

Host events where our church provides social and spiritual entertainment. Events include 5<sup>th</sup> Friday Family Night and monthly dinners for needy families.

Circle of Friends (STF)

Use the sermons from our pastor to lead a small group of unchurched friends and family in a discussion on the topic.

**Ministry Worker (OGS)**

Serve God and His people through your call to a Biblical office or 5-fold ministry (apostle, prophet, evangelist, master teacher, pastor, deacon, elder, or minister).

**Spiritual Growth and Development (OGS)**

Help others with their life issues and lead them into a meaningful relationship with Christ through prayer and ongoing prayer support, and discipleship classes.

Altar Workers/Prayer Partners (OGS)

Connect with those who come to the altar for salvation, or prayer needs. This is a ministry for those who love sharing their faith and winning souls into the Kingdom of God.

Prayer Intercessors (OGS)

Meet regularly to pray for special needs within the church and community.

**Membership Relations (OGS)**

Connect members to God, to the church and to each other through personal one on one ministry, fellowship, and Bible Study.

One Accord Partners (OGS)

Serve as an extension of the pastor and oversee a small group of members providing on going pastoral care and assistance for each member/family.

Get Connected Ministry (OGS)

Help members and guests find a ministry that fits their need and their gifts. Uphold our membership ministry creed, "Every member a minister".

Baptism Registrar (OGS)

Help track how many people are accepting Christ and being baptized.

**Administration (OGS)**

Help the church with its daily/weekly/monthly ministry preparation tasks.

Bulletin Creation (OGS)

Work with computer design programs to develop and print the Sunday weekly bulletin.

Communion Preparation (OGS)

Assist in this very holy and sacred ordinance by setting up the sacrament every first Sunday.

Announcements Coordinator (OGS)

Organize the announcements that are to be placed in the Sunday weekly bulletin.

Newsletter and Calendar (OGS)

Keep our guest and membership up to date on all CWC news and events.

Special Event Coordinator (STS)

Oversee the creation and implementation of CWC's special events, which include concerts, conferences, and special holiday events.

Ministry Connection Center (OGS)

Oversee the distribution of information on CWC and messages on CD and DVD, and other preaching, teaching and Bible Study notes.

Sermon Recording and Editing (OGS)

Record and edit the sermon given during the week and at other events on CD and Video. Training provided.

The Light (OGS/STS)

The marketing ministry of CWC. Help our light shine in our community, region, state, country and in country's abroad by calling, emailing, direct mail, website, and other advertising and promotional means.

Website Management (OGS)

Oversee and manage the entire church website keeping it updated and current.

Finance and Accounting (OGS)

Assist with and help manage the church budget and bookkeeping. Help the Pastor do what he hates doing (numbers)!

Transportation (OGS)

Help transport members and attendees to various services and fellowships.

Mailing (STS)

Participate in the preparation of mass mailings to the community and members.

**Equipment Setup and Breakdown (OGS)**

Set up the sanctuary every Friday before the Sunday Worship Celebration and for other events, and break down the equipment after service.

Clean up Crew (OGS)

Restore the beauty of God's temple and campus after Celebration services and special events.

Sanctuary Beautification (STS)

Help create and plan the atmosphere and decor in the sanctuary or building where services and special events are held.

**University of Successful Christian Living (OGS)**

Present the Bible in a real, applicable, life changing style. Assist in designing a 1<sup>st</sup> class Biblical training and learning center at CWC.

Christian Education (OGS)

Help coordinate Sunday and Bible Study classes. Assist with teacher and curriculum scheduling.

School of Leadership (OGS)

Provide on going training for all leaders. Present new methods of training to our leadership team.

School of Ministry (OGS)

Assist in providing and implementing training for those who have responded to and accepted the call of God to ministry (e.g. deacon, preaching, teaching, missionary, etc.).

Teachers and Trainers (OGS)

Classroom Assistance (OGS)
